## New Naval Architecture Program

The University of British Columbia is pleased to announce that it is planning to establish a new Master of Engineering in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering. The program is intended to commence in September 2013, and we are now inviting applicants to the program. The program is concerned with all aspects (design, construction, maintenance and operation) of ships and other structures in the marine environment. The program requires a minimum of 12 months for completion, and includes an intensive set of courses culminating in a capstone design project entailing the design of a vessel, as well as a 12week internship with a company or other organization. The coming decade will see a major increase in shipbuilding projects in Canada, and these will need specialist engineers. UBC recognizes the importance of a highly skilled and educated workforce ready to meet the needs of this growing industry, and so has developed this new program in response to that need.
